Accident & Emergency:

The Allgemeines Krankenhaus (AKH) Viersen provides 24/7 A&E services for General Medicine incl. Cardiology, General Surgery, Gynaecology/Obstetrics, Orthopaedics and Urology.

The **Paediatric A&E department** is located in the Kinderklinik (children's hospital) St Nikolaus at the same address and situated in a building adjacent to the main hospital.

Please note that if emergency services are called to attend to a patient who needs admission to hospital, they have a duty to take the patient to the nearest relevant hospital which may not be AKH Viersen.

Admission:

AKH Viersen:

The AKH Viersen is a Designated German Provider Hospital and following the closure of RAF(H) Wegberg in 1996, Secondary Healthcare Services have been provided by AKH Viersen. The address is:

Ante/Postnatal Services

Dr Uhlig and his team will be looking after you during pregnancy and after delivery. They work closely together with the Host Nation Midwife.

Please note: Should an admission/referral to hospital be necessary during pregnancy or for the delivery of your baby you will be referred to AKH Viersen

Appointments:

Cancellation and/or changing of appointments please contact you Hospital Hotline.

Cardiology:

A dedicated Cardiology department including a Chest Pain Unit is available at the AKH Viersen.

Car Park:

The main car park opposite the hospital can be used if a blue parking disc (Parkscheibe) is displayed and for a limited period of up to 2 hours.

There is a free car park with unlimited parking approx. 50 metres away from the hospital (directly across from the flower shop)

Free parking is available on Hoserkirchweg but this is very limited.

Consent:

You may be requested to provide written consent for your Host Nation GP, Community and Hospital staff to provide medical information to the Medical Administration Unit, Patient Support Officers and BFG Hospital Administration either in person or by telephone. This will enable information to be added to your medical documents and if necessary for it to be translated so that your medical records are complete on handover to another region or on return to UK.

Data Protection:

All staff have a duty to ensure that personal information, given in confidence, remains confidential. Sharing of information is strictly governed by information protocols and the Code of Practice for confidentiality. These are produced in accordance with the relevant UK and German legislation and good practice and are designed to protect your rights. All staff are required to work within these guidelines.

You may receive care from other professionals and so that all are able to work together for your benefit, information about you will only be passed on to the people who have genuine need for it. The providers adhere to both the Data Protection Act 1998 and all statutory requirements regarding confidentiality or to the relevant German laws whilst following the appropriate guidelines for information security.

DCA Opinion:

It is important for serving personnel to contact the Hospital Hotline, when referred to Hospital for investigation and/or treatment. Your referral will be reviewed and where required discussed with the relevant Defence Consultant Advisor to ensure the proposed treatment does not have an Occupational Health impact on your career.

Discharge

When discharged from hospital make sure you have been briefed on conduct after discharge, received a discharge letter, a prescription for medication, if to be continued after discharge. Make sure you receive a follow-up appointment, if necessary, or, if not sure or unable to arrange prior to leaving hospital, please contact the Hospital Hotline and they will assist you.

European Health Insurance Card (EHIC):

This card covers the bearer for urgent and unforeseen treatment only in an EEA country outside the country of residence (posting). Family Planning:

Your Host Nation GP will be able to advise you and, if necessary, refer you to the relevant provider.

General Surgery:

General & Visceral Surgery are provided at AKH Viersen.

Intensive Care/High Dependency Care:

Outpatient Department AKH Viersen:

The Outpatient Department (OPD) AKH Viersen is responsible for outpatient clinics including those at external providers.

Paediatric Services:

Paediatric Services are provided by the children's hospital St Nikolaus Kinderklinik, Hoserkirchweg 63, 41747 Viersen, Tel: 02162 1040. Routine referrals are directed via your Host Nation GP.

In case of an emergency the children's hospital provides a 24/7 A&E service to the community.

Pain Management: see Neurology.

Patient Support Services:

If you need language support while in hospital, please call the bilingual Patient Support Team via the Hospital Hotline.

Physiotherapy:

Your Host Nation GP or the hospital clinician can prescribe 6 sessions of physiotherapy. If further physiotherapy is required, you will have to return to the prescriber for a review.

Pharmacy:

If you receive a prescription you should take it to the Löwen Apotheke, Plektrudis Str.9, 41179 Mönchengladbach. Tel: 02161 580210.

You will be asked to show the letter to confirm your entitlement and to sign confirming the receipt of the medication. The staff will explain how to take it and provide you with written instructions in English.

Pre-Admission:

AKH Viersen provides a pre-admission clinic for all planned surgery. If surgery is indicated and a date has been agreed, you will also be given a date for a pre-admission appointment. You will have to report to the admission office to register. A nurse will prepare relevant documentation and take blood, if necessary. You will then see the consultant where you have the opportunity to ask any questions you may have about the procedure and aftercare. The anaesthetist will inform you about anaesthetics. You will be asked to consent to surgery and anaesthetics once you have been fully informed about procedures.

Radiology:

The majority of radiology services such as X-ray, CT and MRT are provided by AKH Viersen. More specialist services i.e. DEXA scans are referred to a different provider. You will be advised by your GP or the Outpatient Department where to go.

Rheumatology:

Rheumatology will be provided by AKH Viersen.

Routine Referrals:

Should your Host Nation GP advise that you require a routine referral to the Hospital for investigation and/or treatment they will refer you to the relevant departments of AKH Viersen or community based practices.

Your GP will liaise with the Medical Admin Unit (MAU) at Brunnsun, to organise your referral to the Outpatient Department AKH Viersen. Once a referral has been received they will contact you to confirm appointment time and location.
